

Code of Conduct for International Students of JHUN

Article 1 Observe the relevant laws and decrees formulated by the Chinese government.

Article 2 Obey the university rules and regulations.

Article 3 Respect the faculty and staff members of the university.

Article 4 Respect the habits and customs of people from different nations. Maintain and promote international friendship and unity. Respect the autonomy and dignity of sovereign states. Disparaging activities or remarks about other nations, cultures or beliefs are also forbidden.

Article 5 Complete assignments allotted by the university.

Article 6 Participate in regular exercise, pay attention to hygiene, and take care of public property.

Article 7 Various customs and religious beliefs shall be respected, and international students may observe their traditional festivals with the approval of the university at the designated place; no words or deeds shall violate the social public ethics of China or of other countries. However, any form of religious propaganda or religious mission shall be prohibited.

Article 8 Work-study activities could be allowed with the permission of the school but the students shall not engage in other jobs or commercial activities.

Article 9 Promotion of and participation in religious missions are strictly prohibited in China. Distributing or posting religious publicity materials without prior approval of the university is strictly forbidden.

Article 10 International students are encouraged to get engaged in various university activities, such as the orientation, the commencement, sports meetings, and recreational activities.

Article 10 International students are encouraged to participate in and organize extracurricular activities. However, the School of International Education must approve the participation of any Chinese students or staff in these activities.

Article 12 Based on China's holiday system, international student classes are suspended during weekends, Chinese Labor Day, National Day and other holidays. Summer and winter vacation time is set by the university calendar. International students must attend classes as usual, even during the holiday periods of their home countries. Any exceptions will be announced beforehand by the School of International Education.
